Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:		<p>This Project will consist of uplifting and enhancing additional 0.91-acres to the existing 1.61-acre section of the El Dorado Ranch Park in Yucaipa, CA. For the 0.91-acre restoration, the Inland Empire Resource Conservation District (“IERCD”) will conduct site preparation by treating and removing the herbaceous weeds that currently vegetate the property. This will be followed by the introduction of Milkweed and other native plants for Monarch and pollinator habitat. In total, there the site will consist of 2.52-acres of Monarch pollinator habitat.</p> <p>On June 11th, 2026, the IERCD Board of Directors approved the Project.</p>

Reason why project was exempt:	<p>The basis for the District’s determination that the project is exempt is detailed below:</p> <p>Small Habitat Restoration Projects: This Project is exempt pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines, section 15333, which applies to small habitat restoration projects. The Project will consist of a 2.52-acre restoration to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection for Monarch and other pollinator habitat. Furthermore, this project will create native habitat that will benefit other native wildlife. There will be no significant impacts to endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15065; no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed; and the project will not result in significant impacts when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, other current projects, and probable future projects.</p> <p>None of the exceptions enumerated in State CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 apply to the exemptions applicable here.</p>

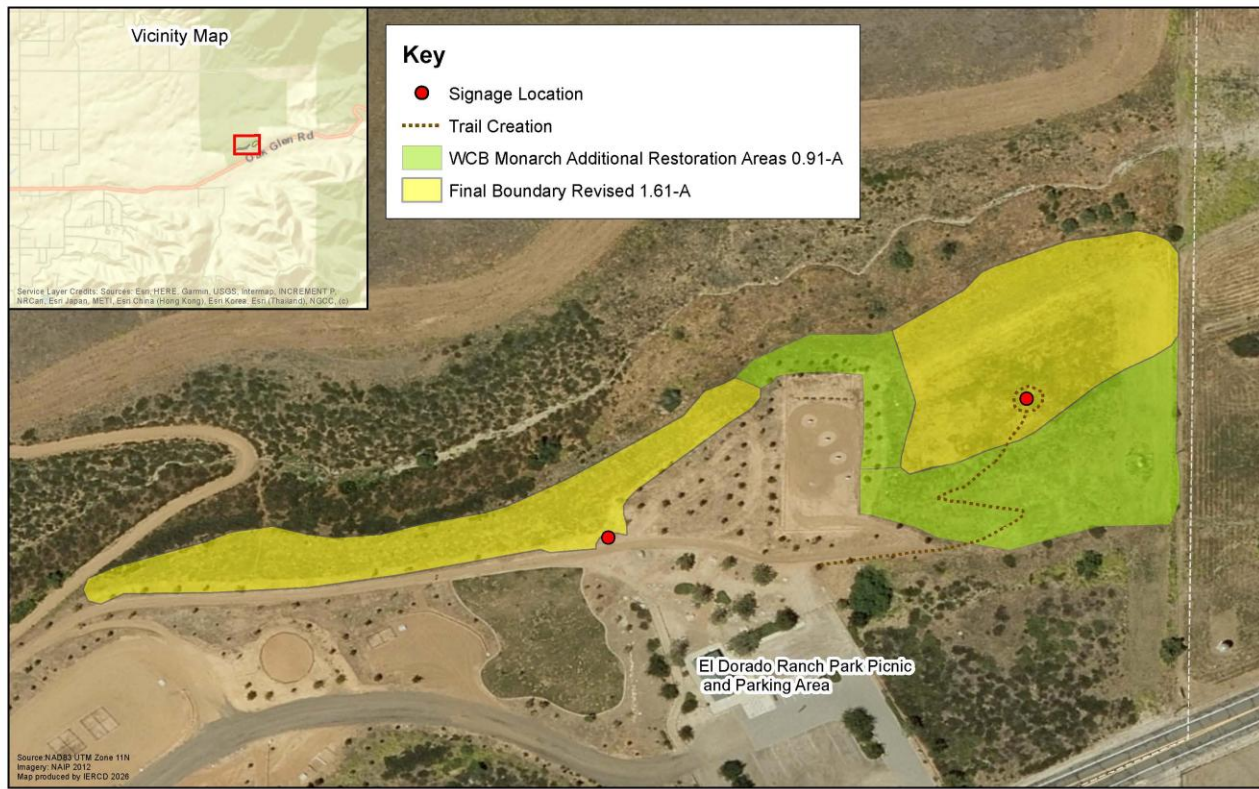
