

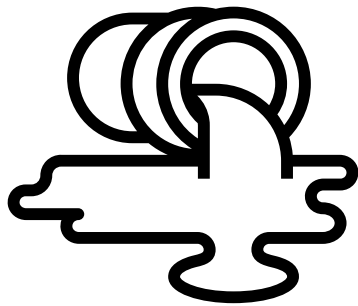
# WATER IN YOUR VALLEY

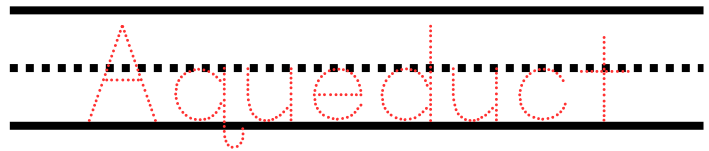

### Aqueduct:

A special structure built to carry water from one place to another, using pipes, ditches, canals, tunnels, or more.

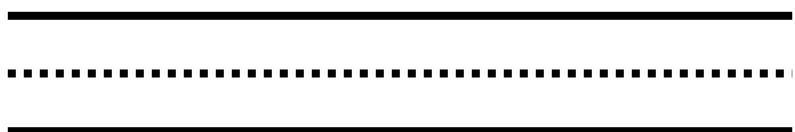
### Condensation:

A part of the water cycle where H<sub>2</sub>O changes from a gas (called water vapor) to a liquid. Condensation happens when water in the air gets cold and collects together into tiny drops of water.

*Imagine you have a cold glass of water on a hot day. After a little while, you might see water droplets forming on the outside of the glass. That's condensation!*



## Conservation:

Using something carefully so we don't waste it. For water, it means saving water and not using more than we need.

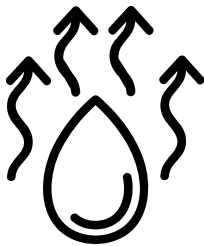

## Evaporation:

A part of the water cycle that happens when water gets warm and turns into a gas, going up in the air. Example: When a puddle dries up in the sun.

## Gas:

A form of matter that doesn't have a shape or size and can spread out everywhere. Example: The air we breathe.

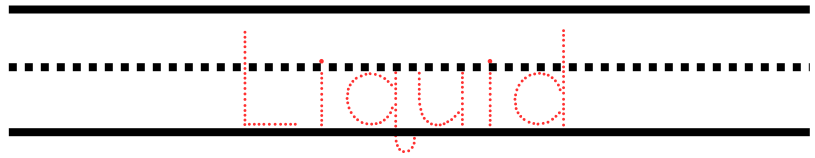
## Liquid:

A form of matter that is fluid, can flow, and can take the shape of its container.

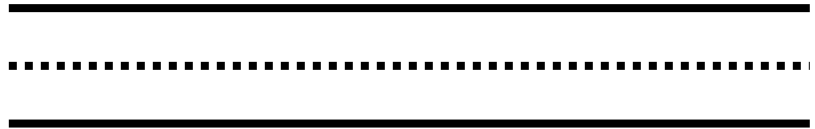
Example: Water in a cup.

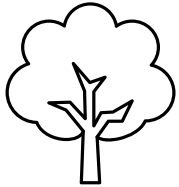

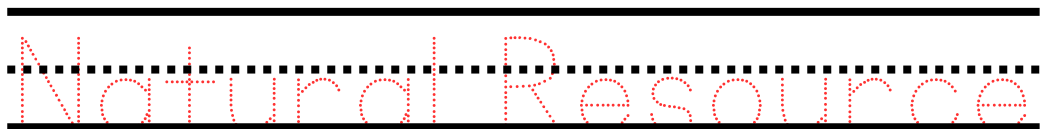


## Natural Resource:

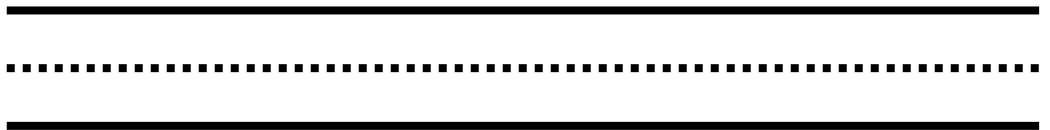
Something we get from nature that we use to live, like water, trees, and sunlight.

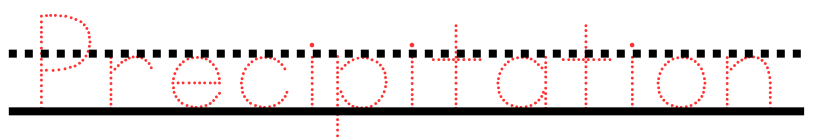


## Precipitation:

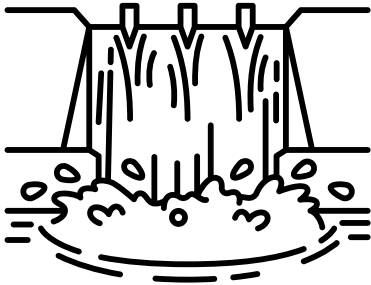

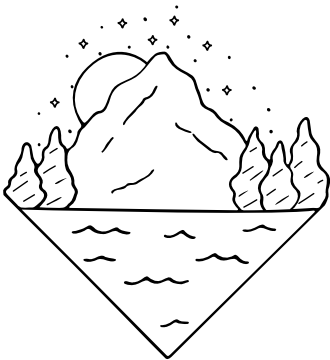
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## Silverwood Lake:

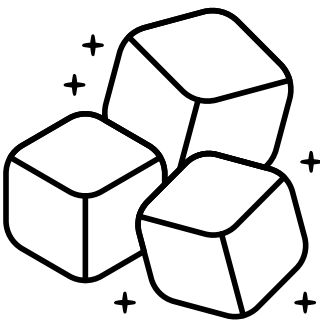
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## Solid:

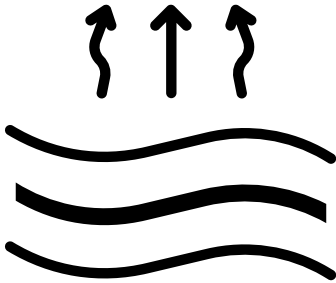
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## Transpiration:

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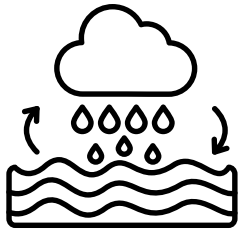
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## Water Cycle:

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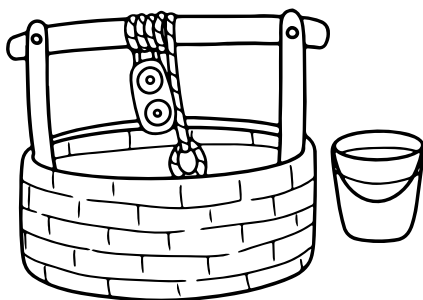
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## Well:
